in 2018

10 adults gained their external high school diplomas

11 earned their U.S. citizenship

since 1987

9,200 instructional hours where students learn basic math, reading, and writing, speaking, citizenship skills through free, one-on-one tutoring, and class sessions, and distance learning.

90% of Project Literacy students are foreign-born, coming from **45** different countries and speaking **30** languages

73 students have received their high school diplomas
