Customers are greeted by an expanded *Customer Service & Research Desk* and inviting, modern seating.

The vibrant children's area, highlighted by a bright new classroom, is double the size of the former space. Books and educational toys abound throughout this area for our youngest customers through fifth grade students.

On the second floor, 72 computers feature the best, most contemporary specialized online research tools and instructional sites for students and researchers. A new STEM classroom offers a venue for learning the latest trends in science, while HCLS Project Literacy features triple its former educational space, including a new classroom.
