To create an account to access the portal, HCLS customers can go to **lynda.com**, click "Log In" in the upper right corner, select the "Organizational Login" tab, enter HCLS' website URL (hclibrary.org), and click the "Go" button. Users will then be prompted to enter their HCLS library card number and PIN.

HCLS customers have access to the entire **lynda.com** catalog of classes. The **lynda.com** website is also optimized for mobile browsing and can be accessed from an Internet-enabled tablet or smartphone.

Lynda.com is the latest addition to the *HCLSNow!* catalog of free, on demand, self-directed, online educational tools. Available anytime, anywhere, *HCLS Now!* is the gateway for customers to access, stream, and download free, on-demand content 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
