# Missions: Ages 0-10

June 1: Mission 1
Ages 0-10: Popsicles  Make popsicles by pouring juice into ice cube trays and placing a toothpick in each cube. Freeze then eat!
Ages 0-4: Food Taste & Texture  Pick a letter and eat three foods with that letter. Describe how they taste and feel.
Ages 0-4: Food Science Add food coloring to cups of water and put in celery stalks. What do you think will happen?
Ages 5-10: Letter-Writing Write a letter to someone to brighten their day.
Ages 5-10: Garden Craft Collect an object from nature with a lot of nooks and crannies and build a bug hotel!
June 1: Mission 2
Ages 0-10: Father's Day Fun  Make a card for a father, a friend's father, an uncle, or grandfather.
☐ Ages 0-4: Food Colors & Names  Talk about the color of foods and their names.
Ages 0-4: Food & Books Read a book about food. Pretend to be one of the characters and retell the story.
Ages 5-10: Bee Garden Plant a sun-loving flower to attract and feed bees.
Ages 5-10: Gratitude Challenge Send someone a thank you note or write a letter saying why you are thankful for them. Then, challenge them to do the same.

#### June 8: Mission 3 Ages 0-10: Buddy Belly Breaths At bedtime or anytime, lie on your back and place a small stuffed animal on your belly. Breathe deeply and watch your belly and stuffed animal rise and fall. Ages 0-4: Act Like an Animal Take turns with family or a friend pretending to be different animals and guess which animal the other person is pretending to be. Ages 0-4: Cuddly Critters Talk about the names of baby animals such as kitten, puppy, or calf. Then play "Which animal is bigger?" Ages 5-10: Imagine Your Creature Design your own animal! Draw and write or tell about it! Ages 5-10: Animal Nature Walk Take a walk outside and search for animals. Record what animals you see, the sounds you hear, or what the animals are doing. June 15: Mission 4 Ages 0-10: Numbers Use play dough or another dough to make shapes of the numbers 1 to 10. Ages 0-4: How Many in My Family? Draw a picture of family members who live with you. Count how many people. Ages 0-4: The Best Book Have everyone in your family vote on their favorite picture book. Read the book. Ages 5-10: Flip Out Flip a coin. Guess which side will land face up. See how many times in a row it lands with the same side facing up. Ages 5-10: What Weighs More?

Make a scale. Attach equal lengths of string to two plastic cups and hang them on opposite ends of a hanger. Hang your scale from a doorknob and put different items like marshmallows or coins in the cups to see what weighs more!
