HCPSS will continue to provide Grab-N-Go meal services at their 14 distribution sites throughout the county for at least through the 2019-2020 school year. If you have difficulty picking up meals for your child(ren) at the location or times when meals are served, you can now designate someone to pick up your meals for you.

- Parents/guardians may pick up meals for their children and up to one other family without completing a meal request form.
- Designees may pick up meals for up to four families. Parents/guardians requesting a designee pick up meals for their child(ren) must complete a Meal Request Form:
